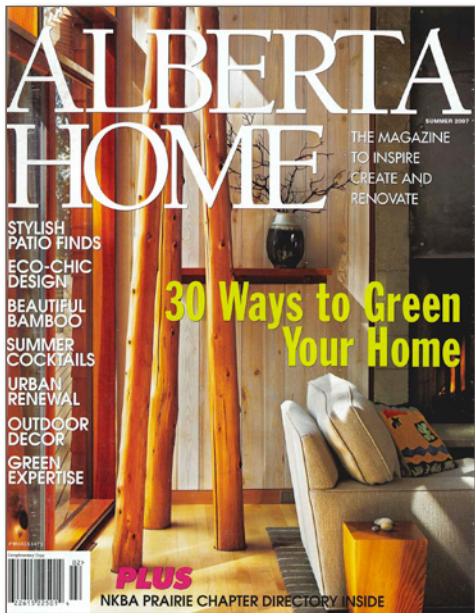

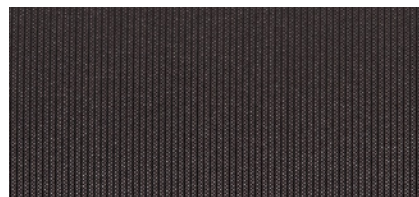

According to Hartmann & Forbes, EcoWeave can be recycled easily at the end of its service life. Through its innovative Take-Back Initiative™ the company collects shades from consumers and recycles them in ways that don't have an adverse impact on the environment.
